Abundance Food Share is collecting and redistributing approximately 20,000 lbs. of food each month in partnership with Carver & Scott County Environmental Services and food diversion programs. We also pick up perishables from food shelves and deliver those items immediately to the hotels with homeless programs for people that have barriers accessing food in traditional ways.
