For many people experiencing homelessness or the potential for being homeless, there are more questions than answers. The first big hurdle is where to start trying to access resources. His House offers a safe entry point with a Resource Center offering food and clothing with no questions asked. Multiple agencies and school counselors refer individuals and families to His House because of this easy access.

Almost every day someone walks through our door saying, "They told me His House would help me." In fact, over 4,000 people walk in to our Resource Center each year. From the free resources we offer on site to coordinated entry and facilitating connections with multiple agencies, His House opens doors for many people who would not even know what doors to look for.
